When: Monday 31st October – Friday 4th November

Depart from school: 8am (sharp) Monday 31st October

Arrive back at school: approx. 2:30-3pm Friday 4th November. It is asked that you be waiting at school for your child at this time. If someone else will be picking up your child, please give them a written note

Overview

A visit to Lake Keepit Sports and Recreation Camp is an opportunity for students to learn new skills, develop closer relationships with peers and be provided new and exciting experiences that improve their resilience and self-esteem. Students will be participating in a variety of outdoor activities from the following categories; heights, aquatic, bush and recreation.

Valuables and Lollies

IPads, phones and tablets are <u>not permitted</u> on this excursion. Staff will take photos that will be available after camp. If an emergency happens at camp, school staff will contact you. Please ensure that you provide accurate contact information.

Bubble gum and chewing gum are not permitted. Valuable items should be left at home. We do not accept responsibility if these items are brought and are either lost, broken or stolen.

Online Registration

Parents will also need to provide dietary and health information for Sport and Recreation staff prior to attending camp. This will be via an online form that must be completed by you at least 4 weeks before we leave. Please keep note of upcoming details being sent home.

Families are welcome to apply for student assistance to help with some of the costs. Contact the school office for more information about this.

Eating

On our journey to Lake Keepit we will stop at Armidale for morning tea. **Students need to bring something for morning tea for themselves.** There will be no eating on the coach. All other meals will be provided at camp.

N.B. Lake Keepit staff will prepare a packed lunch for the return journey.

Students will be allocated group duties to assist in setting up and clean-up for eating times.

Accommodation

Students will stay in comfortable lodges. Male and female students are accommodated in separate lodges. A teacher will stay in a bungalow close to the lodge. Lodge room allocation will be decided closer to the date at a camp meeting. Please see the packing list for bedding requirements.

Medication

All medication must be provided in a sealed envelope, clearly labelled with your child's name and instructions. This includes vitamins or medications like travel-calm. Please ensure the information is comprehensive and clear. Also verbally discuss this with your child's teacher prior to our departure.

Packing checklist:

- Shorts and t-shirts (no singlets, sleeveless or midriff tops)
- Jeans
- Jumpers and tracksuit pants
- Socks and underwear
- Raincoat
- Pyjamas
- Swimming costume and rash shirt
- Sunscreen, sunhat and sunglasses
- Toiletries, including soap (no aerosols)
- Two towels
- Pillow, pillowcase, sleeping bag or sheets and a blanket
- Day-backpack
- Insect repellent (no aerosols)
- Lip balm
- Two pairs of sneakers (one old pair to wear in the water)
- Paper, pens or pencils
- Plastic bags for dirty or wet clothes
- Medications (if required)
- Handkerchief or tissues
- Water bottle

What not to bring to camp:

- Aerosol cans (e.g. spray on deodorant or insect repellent)
- Thongs, Ugg boots or slippers (these cannot be worn around the Centre or on activities)
- Radios or MP3 players
- Computer/video games
- Mobile phones
- Lollies or chewing gum
- Jewellery
- Anything valuable.

Please ensure all items are clearly labelled with your child's name.

A number of meetings covering the above aspects of the excursion will take place in the weeks prior to the excursion. Please encourage your child to ask about anything they are uncertain about. We understand that there may be some anxieties as this is a long camp, we will do our best to relieve any of these anxieties.

If, for any reason, you wish to withdraw your child from the excursion, notification must be made by 31st August. Withdrawals after this date will incur a fee to cover costs.



IMPORTANT: There are two notes that need to be completed prior to the excursion:
