'The Human Race' addresses anti-bullying in schools and provides support and confidence for vulnerable children. The performance reinforces resilience and encourages tolerance, kindness, respect and empathy. It is a humorous and entertaining way to help children understand that although we are from different cultures and have different abilities, human beings all have feelings and need to be accepted and respected for who we are.

The story explains how Dunc's **loyalty**, **honesty** and tenacity are his greatest strengths but, if he is to win the physical, artistic and mental challenges in the Human Race, he will have to overcome his **low self-esteem**. Deedee has **lied about her age** and **alienated** people by **posting mean photos** and comments. She is horrified when she has to enter the race with Dunc, the 'daggiest' kid in the whole school. They win because they are **resourceful**, **compassionate**, **play by the rules** and **do their best** to reach their potential as **citizens of the world**.
