School maintenance

Last week approval was given for about \$30 000 to be spent on school building maintenance over the coming year. The two buildings, currently housing Stage 3 students, behind the new music room will be painted and tidied up and there will be some retaining walls built on the bank side of the big covered area – to prevent the mud and runoff pooling on the concrete play area.

This is great news for us all.

I was in Sydney last week for a series of meetings as part of the Primary Principals' Association. The minister, The Hon. Adrian Piccoli, the Director General, Dr Michelle Brunniges, together with other senior Department staff took the time to speak with us.

Of particular note were the changes to the department under the new funding arrangements, and the expectations around the implementation of the National Curriculum, together with flagging for 2013 further strategies around catering for students with disabilities, again within a National framework.
