Come get creative with 1/2 Orange!

Last term the children put their creative thinking caps on and worked together to adapt a few chapters from the book we were reading in class, The Magic Faraway Tree by Enid Blyton to be suitable for a stage-play. They ensured it had enough characters, a strong moral and interesting dialogue. Over the many weeks practising their play, we worked on dramatic techniques such voice projection, as characterisation and blocking to ensure they were ready for the stage 1 concert. The children also wrote a soundscape and used percussion and voice to act as an orchestra, providing the sound effects for the play. They performed brilliantly!
